The 3rd edition of balloonalps – THE ALPS CROSSING EVENT in Zell am See-Kaprun is over. This means that the 4th edition is on its way: balloonalps February 10-17, 2018.

The third edition of balloonalps – THE ALPS CROSSING EVENT took place in Zell am See-Kaprun from February 11-18, 2017. Balloons from Austria, Germany, Lithuania, Czech Republic, Spain and Great Britain joined us in this great event this year.

In terms of competitions, this year's event was a home victory for Inge and Richard Mayerhofer, as their performance was the most stable during all 7 competitions. They were even able to beat the former world champion and multiple European champion David Bareford (GB). The Lithuanian team Skisky with their pilot Vytas Kerkodas came in third. But the picturesque mountain views of Zell am See-Kaprun enchanted all participants.

On Saturday, February 11, all participants met at the TAUERN SPA in Zell am See-Kaprun for a briefing and the welcome cocktail. ON February 14, pilots and crews met for an evening event at the Casino in Zell am See and a special balloonalps roulette tournament.

2.500 people came to see the Night of the Balloons in Kaprun, 4.500 at the Night of the Balloons in Zell am See. The colorful balloon envelops fascinated visitors of all ages. Other highlights of this year's program were a ski and snowboard show, torch relay, airshow with model helicopters, a laser show and the amazing final fireworks.

Children really enjoyed the show with the model balloon. The daily shows at the airfield in Zell am See offered insights into the world of balloons to local kids as well as to vacationers. 555 children in Kindergartens and schools around Zell am See were visited by Jupp Hein, the model balloonist. He also visited retirement homes where over 30 people enjoyed his model balloon shows. He could collect 1000 Euros for the foundation "Kindertraum".

The airship was new at the balloonalps and turned out to be a real highlight. Passengers could book airship rides around the plain in Zell am See and experience a unique adventure.

On Friday, February 17, the ballooning week came to an end with the award ceremony at Kaprun Castle. We would like to thank all those responsible from the region of Zell am See-Kaprun, our sponsors and partners as well as our great team that made this fantastic week possible.

"Five out of six was the number of competitions the weather conditions allowed for during the third edition of balloonalps in 2017. This was possible thanks to the high-pressure weather conditions during this week. In the beginning of the week the weather was fantastic but unfortunately only little winds prevailed. In this weather, it can easily that a balloon becomes difficult to steer - as was the case for one team that had to make an unplanned landing near the "Nagelköpfl" in Peisendorf. High up on the ridge the landing site was inaccessible via car, so a helicopter had to gather balloon basket, envelop as well as the good-humored and unharmed crew. In my opinion, Tuesday and Wednesday were the most perfect days of the whole week. High-altitude winds from south-east made it possible to fly for 250 km – and pass by Chiemsee and Munich. This is what pilots dream about! The "Night of the Balloons" in Kaprun and Zell am See which amazed many thousands of spectators ran smoothly at calm winds. One of my personal favorites was the participation of the team from Dresden with their airship."

While hot air balloons lift off in the morning hours and then disappear behind the horizon for spectators, the airship flies around the valley and comes back to the airfield after about 40 minutes. This gave many spectators the possibility to get a look at an airship from up close. Passengers that took a ride with the hot air balloons or the airship have had impressive moments that will last a long time. A wonderful week has passed without any noteworthy accidents. "Already at the first briefing it became clear that high pressure weather conditions, dry and with a lot of sunshine, would prevail during the week of balloonalps. The high-altitude winds turned from soft breezes from south-west to northern winds for a short period. In the middle of the week winds came from the south-east and grew stronger. Until then, only local flights were possible, but then, on Tuesday and Wednesday long distance flights to the area around Munich were possible. Fogs posed no problem at all, in Pinzgau there were only a few low wafts of mist and by the time the balloons took off dry winds had blown fogs and mists in the landing area away already. Also, surface winds were favorable, aside form a few stronger winds in the area of Lake Zell. Winds were very calm when the Nights of the balloons took place on Monday and Wednesday. On Thursday, the sunny and mild weather allowed for some flights in the close vicinity before a cold front set an end to the high-pressure days."
